

Stanton Lanier - 2017 Technical Rider

A Piano/Multi-Media Experience

Instrument Requirements

- Concert or baby grand piano that is tuned A440 for performance.
- Can perform on electronic keyboard if preferred, or if a piano is not available.

Lighting Requirements

- Soft lighting washes in varying colors throughout performance.
- Some spot lighting on the piano for select pieces.

Audio-Visual Requirements (Visuals are Optional)

- Lapel or over-ear microphone preferred for speaking, audience interaction.
- Prefer playing pianos without microphone if acoustics allow for this.
- Medium to large projection screen(s) to display visuals.
- Visual projection system to connect with Artist notebook computer.
- Visuals do not have any sound; no audio is not needed for visuals.
- Can use LCD projector with portable screen or back wall for smaller venues.
- Some concerts could include guest artist(s) for selected duets on violin, cello, or English horn. These artist requirements will be provided as needed.

Stage Plot Information

- Piano is typically center stage with screen for visuals above and/or behind piano.
- Secondary arrangement is piano to left center with screen and visuals in center.
- Any other artists accompanying typically stand next to the piano.
